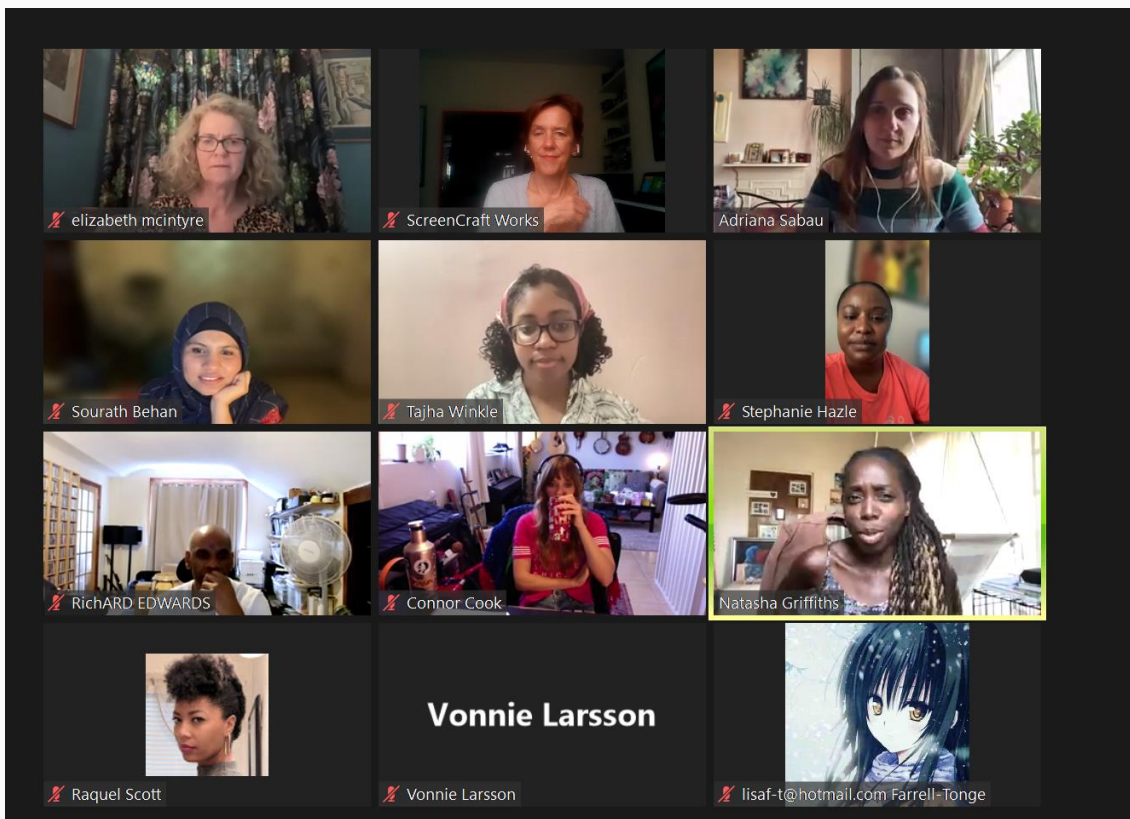

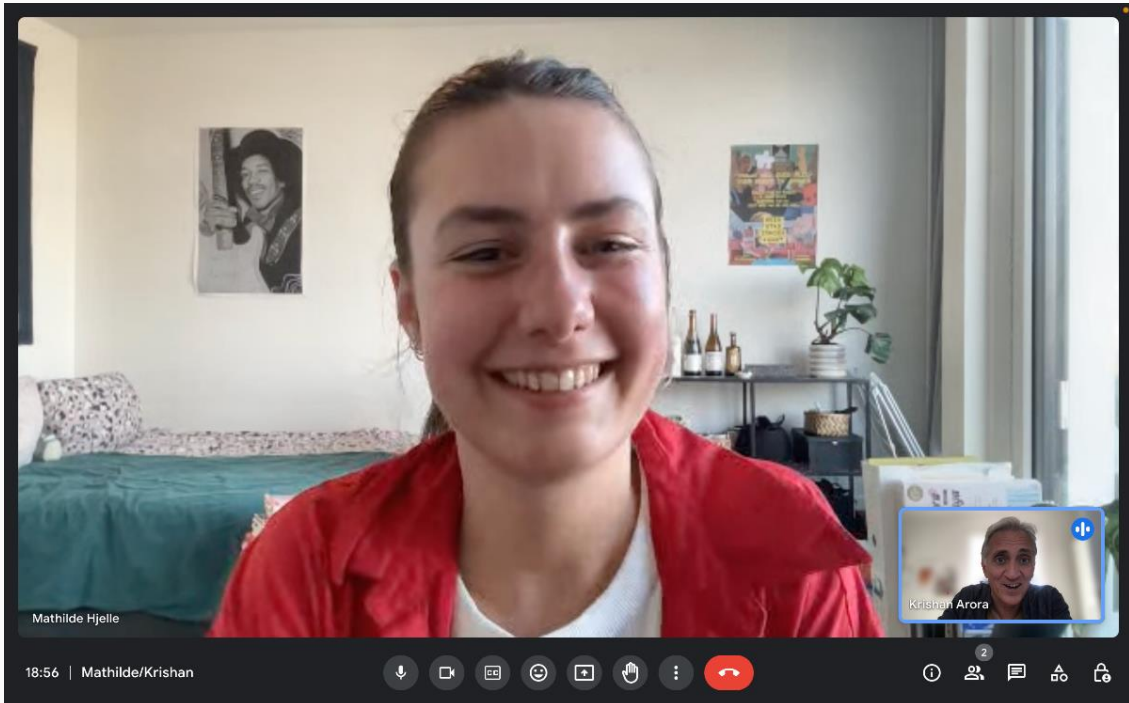
Cross-Border Mentoring
