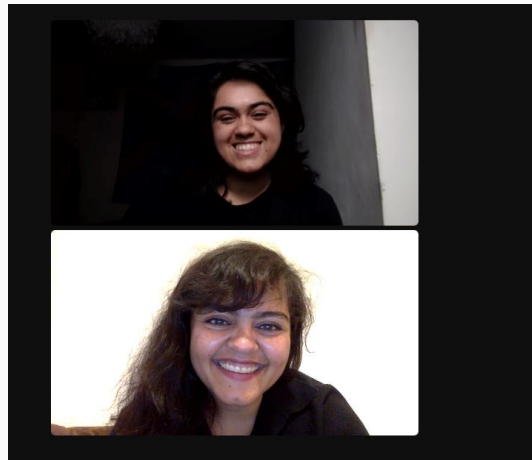
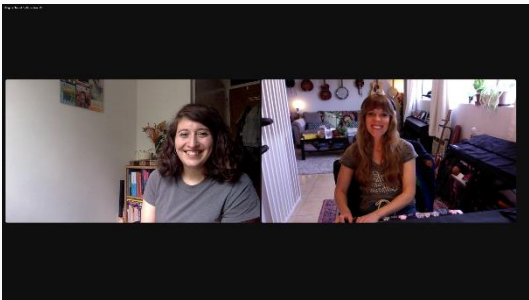
## Cross-Border Networking
